

Over the past month, the average rent for a studio apartment in Vancouver increased by 10% to \$2,295. The average rent for a 1bedroom apartment increased by 2% to \$2,500, and the average rent for a 2-bedroom apartment decreased by -7% to \$3,500.


# Dunbar-Southlands



Quiet, tree-lined streets overlooking Vancouver offer a refuge from the commotion of city life. Visit Dunbar Community Centre for summer day camps and classes for kids of all ages, or take advantage of childcare facilities while you squeeze in a cycling or dance workout. Many of the restaurants in Dunbar's small retail district cater to children—Kokopelli Café on Dunbar Street, for example, even has a play area for kids to enjoy while you eat. The majority of the neighborhood's homes are single-family, so you'll benefit from rare parking and backyard space inside city limits.

# Average rent in Dunbar-Southlands

Average rent in Dunbar-Southlands is surprisingly well below the city-wide average for Vancouver, at \$2,025 for a one-bedroom, unfurnished unit as of May 2022. The area has a lot of older, larger homes for rent as well, with two-bedroom units renting for an average of \$2,800 per month, and three-bedroom units renting for an average of \$3,900 according to the last data from Zumper.




### Schools & amenities in Dunbar-Southlands


Southlands Elementary School serves the Southlands community, but there are plenty of other options nearby as well. The prestigious St. George's School is located within the neighborhood, as are Lord Kitchener and Bayview Elementary Schools. As for amenities, Pacific Spirit Park is within walking distance of much of the neighborhood, with a large expanse of biking and walking trails that will take you all the way to the University Endowment Lands, or Jericho Beach. There are more parks practically everywhere one looks, and the Dunbar Community Centre offers a variety of programming for area residents.





### **Transportation in Dunbar-Southlands**






# West Point Grey




Nestled on the western tip of the peninsula, West Point Grey offers family-friendly living in a scenic location. Watch the sunset over the mountains from Jericho Beach or Spanish Banks, two of the neighborhood's most popular beaches. Multiple concession/washroom facilities, tennis and volleyball courts, and "quiet areas" make these beaches an ideal setting for a family BBQ. The Seawall, a paved walking and biking path, connects the area to Downtown. Like its neighbor, Dunbar, West Point Grey offers an excellent selection of schools and a wide array of kid-friendly options at its local recreation center and in its burgeoning retail district.

With all this on offer, it's no wonder West Point Grey commands such high prices both in real estate and rentals. As of our latest May 2022 Vancouver Rent Report, average rent for an unfurnished, one-bedroom unit in the neighborhood was \$2,250 – which was just below the city-wide average. For two- and three-bedroom units, prices were similarly high at \$3,571 for a twobedroom unit, and a whopping \$5,306 for three-bedroom units.





# Schools & amenities in West Point Grey




# **Renfrew-Collingwood**


### Schools & amenities in Renfrew-Collingwood






### Kensington-Cedar Cottage




### Average rent in Kensington-Cedar Cottage





### Schools & amenities in Kensington-Cedar Cottage






### Average rent in Shaughnessy


### Schools & amenities in Shaughnessy








### Kitsilano


